

Florida Household Pulse

May 14th - May 19th

The Household Pulse survey is designed to inform federal, state, and local responses to the needs of its community. It measures household experiences during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Approximately 20% of the total population over 18 years old in Florida reported having **no confidence** in their ability to pay the upcoming months rent, while 31.4% of those who experienced loss of employment income expressed having **no confidence** and 23.7% expressed having only **slight confidence** in their ability to pay the rent.

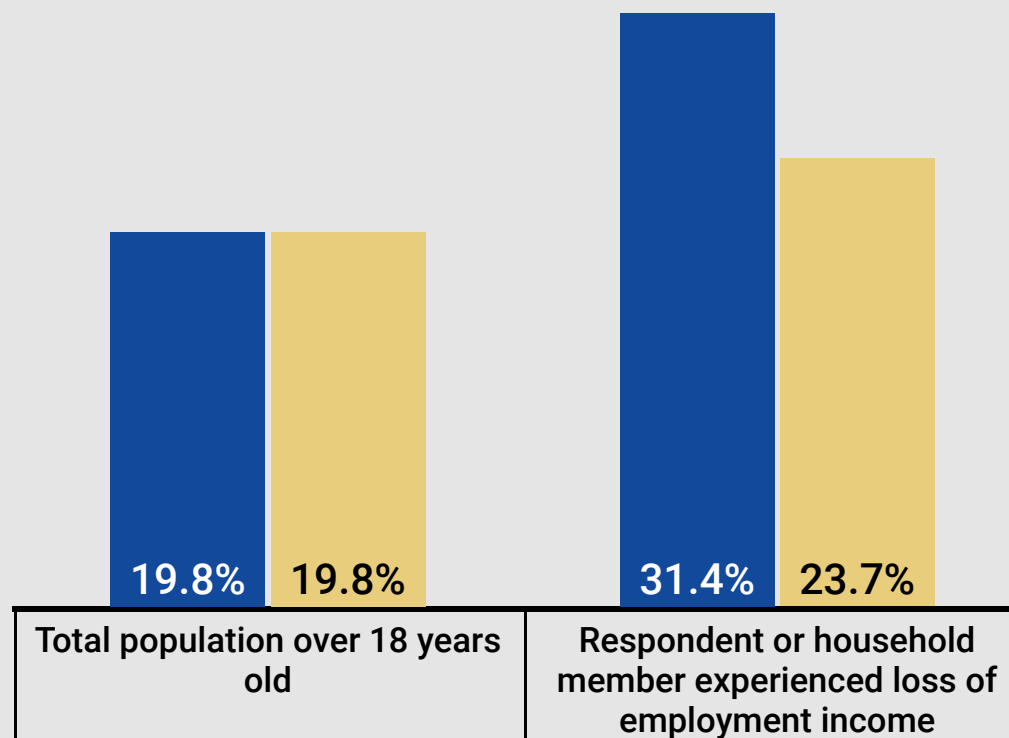

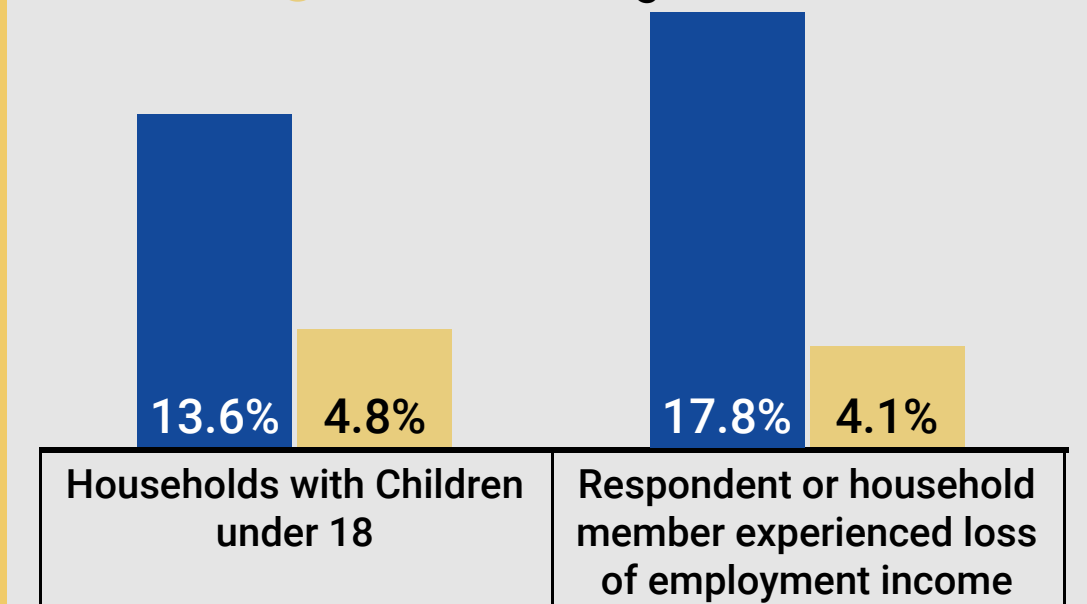
Confidence in Ability to Pay Rent
