# 244 MILLION

is the forecasted number of turkeys raised in the United States in 2016, a 4.5% increase from 2015. The state of Minnesota topped in turkey production (44.5 million), followed by North Carolina (33.5 million), Arkansas (26.0 million), Indiana (19.5 million), Missouri (19.2 million) and Virginia (17.2 million).

### What is the average weight of turkeys?

The average weight for turkeys enjoyed in Thanksgiving is 16 pounds.

The number of years ago President Lincoln first established Thanksgiving as an annual Holiday in 1863.



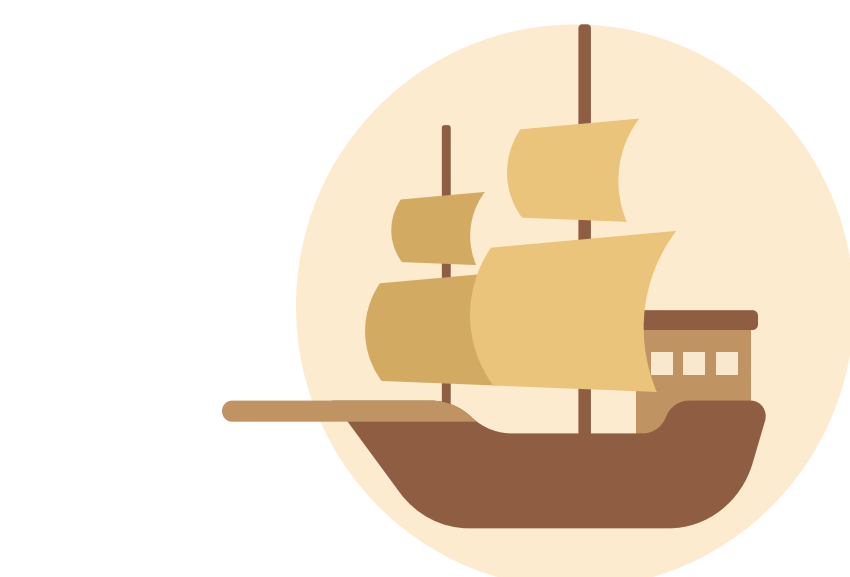
### A Foreign Turkey

118.9 million

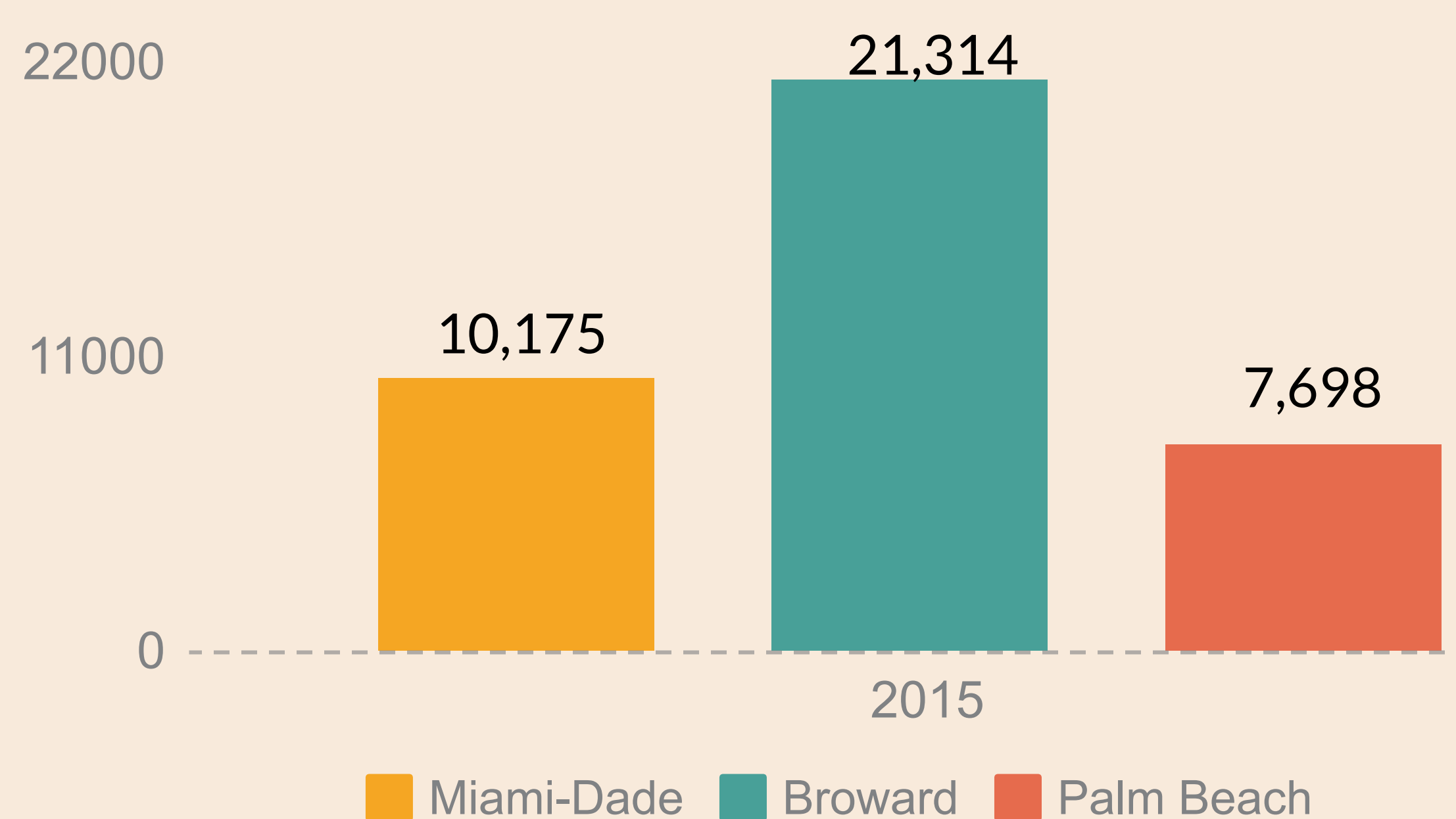
Occupied housing units across the nation in the second quarter of 2017. These are potential stops for Thanksgiving dinner.



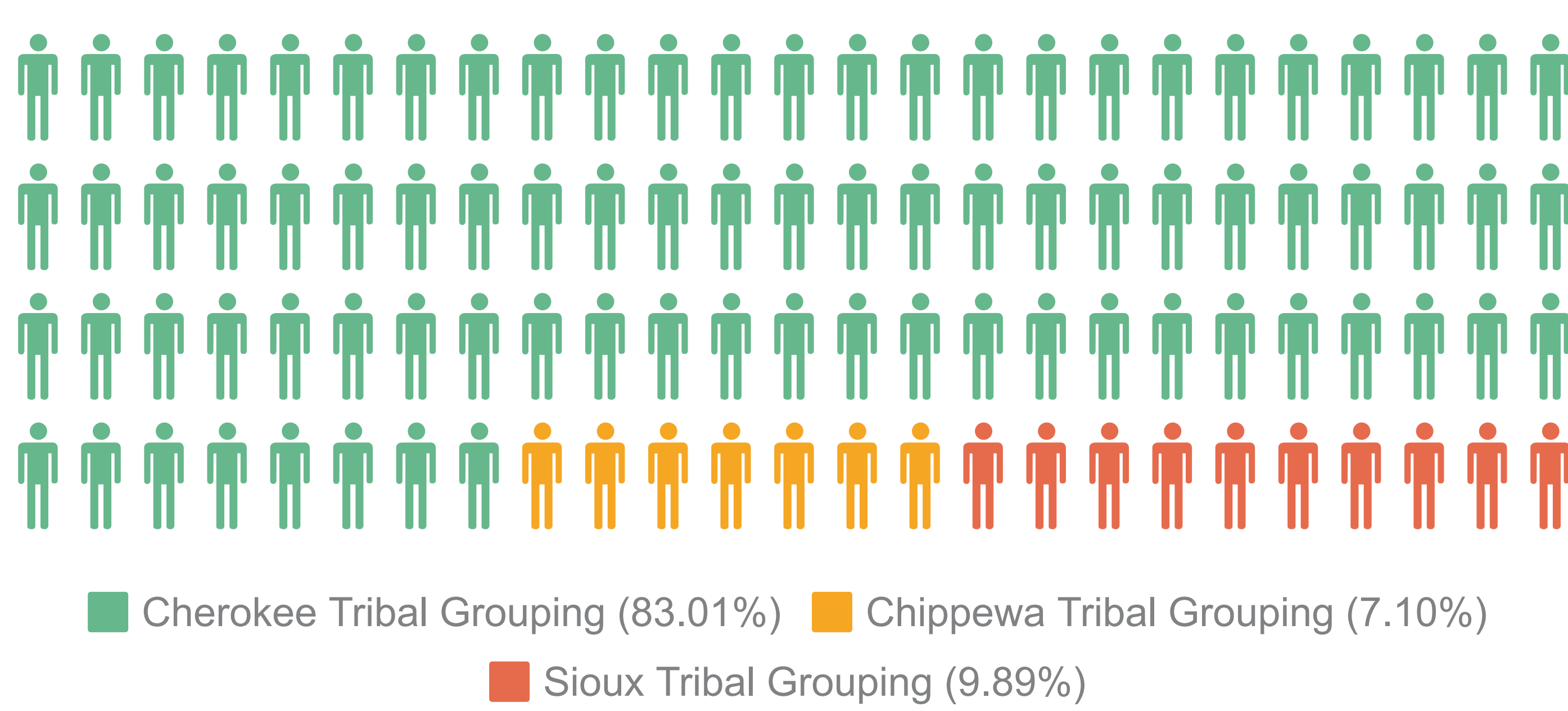
## South Florida
