Coffee drinking U.S. consumers by age group 2020:


% of Population Drinking a Cup or More of Coffee a Day




## Coffee Consumption Trends

The NCA conducted a survey, released in March 2022, to see how the pandemic affected American coffee consumption.

Since January 2020,





at home coffee consumption rose from 77% to 84% and steadily remained at above-pre-pandemic levels.


Americans choosing to drink coffee each day over any other beverage, including water, rose from 52% to 66%.

While at work coffee preparation fell 55% over the 16 months, on-the-go options, including app and drive-thru orders increased 30%.
