



FL has the highest # of veterans over age 75 (>**376K** or **27.8%** of veteran population in FL).









Veteran Educational Attainment, 2021*



The proportion of veterans with less than high school education increased by 7.0% from 2016.



72.4% of veterans have some college, associate, or Bachelor's degrees or higher levels of educational attainment compared to 55.7% for nonveterans.




The proportion of veterans with at least a Bachelor's degree decreased by 11.3% from 2016.

Veteran Median Income



From 2016 to 2021, veteran median income increased by 23.7% from \$36,941 to \$45,700.



From 2016 to 2021, median income increased by 24.4% and 32.6% for veteran males and females respectively.



The median income pay gap between non-veteran males and females in 2021 was 29.3%, the veteran pay gap was 2.9%.*

*Median income for veterans reflects disability and retirement payments, as well as higher levels of educational attainment among male and female veterans.



Veteran Racial/Ethnic Stats, 2021



Most veterans in Miami-Dade identify as Hispanic/Latino (31%) and Black/African American (21%).



The majority of veterans in USA identify as non-Hispanic White (68%).
