PHILADELPHIA.



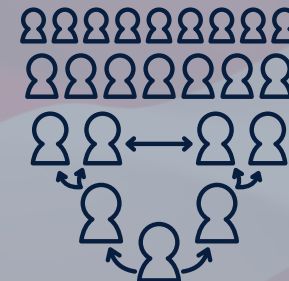

TIMES MORE THAN IN 1780.



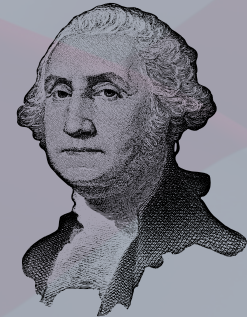

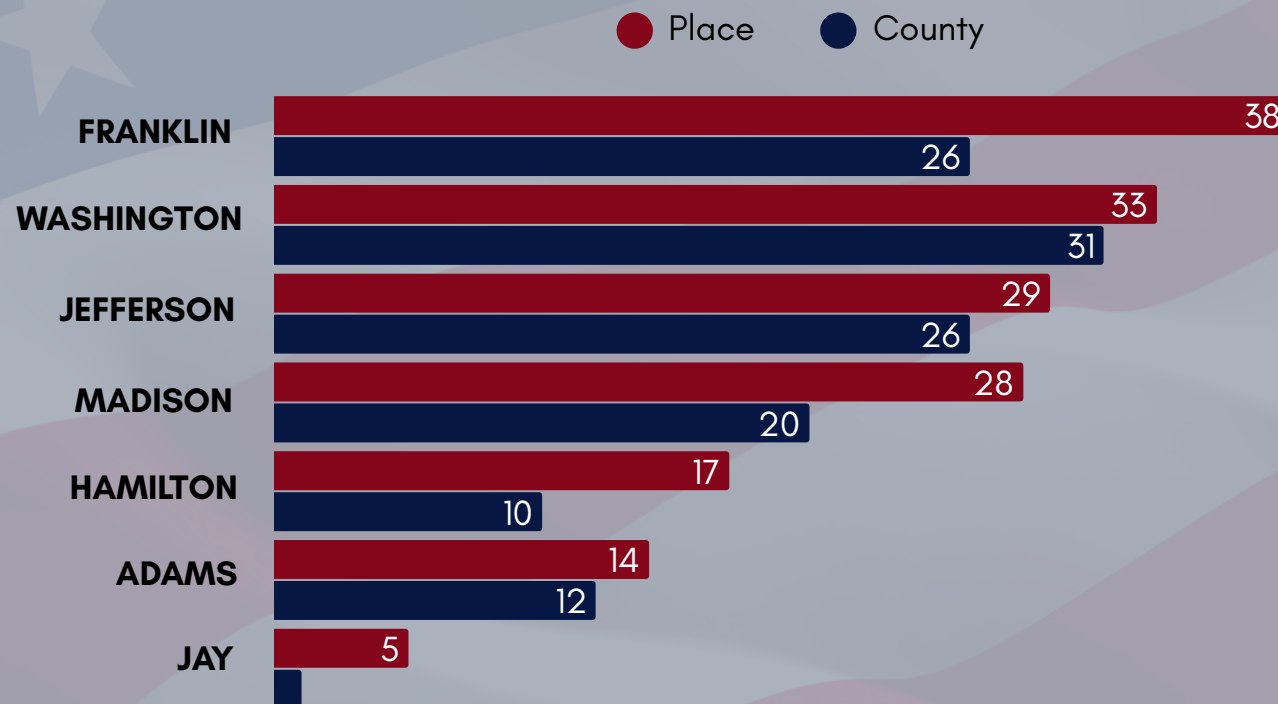

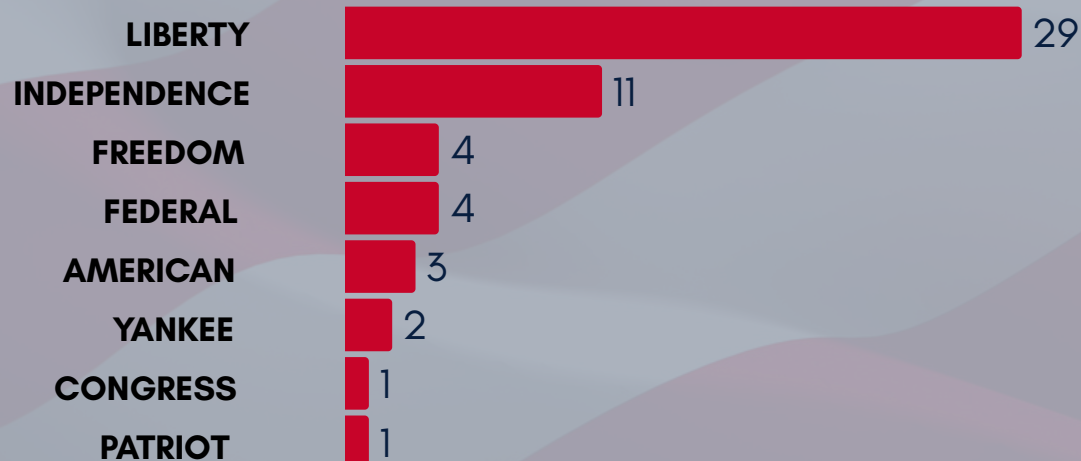


"LIBERTY" (MOST COMMON)
