


POPULATION CHANGE IN SOUTH FLORIDA, 2023-2024


- South Florida's three counties gained 123,471 new residents.
- The tri-county area increased by 1.9% to 6,457,988 residents.
- The Miami metro area was ranked #4 among the top 10 U.S. metro areas by numeric growth.


