





Regional Metrics



7,123 Regional Farmers

- 98% of the total market value of goods sold came from large producers (50+ acres) engaging in larger sales values (\$50k +).
- 90% of the region's producers are white by race
- 42% of farmers have Hispanic origins

- 28% seasonal labor


Biggest crop production in the region



- \$288 million total payroll for workforce







· Only 2% of total land area allotted to agricultural production



• Their production of sugarcane, constituting around **75%** of the state's production level, covers roughly **1/3 of the county's overall landmass**.




