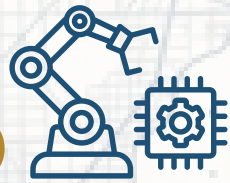

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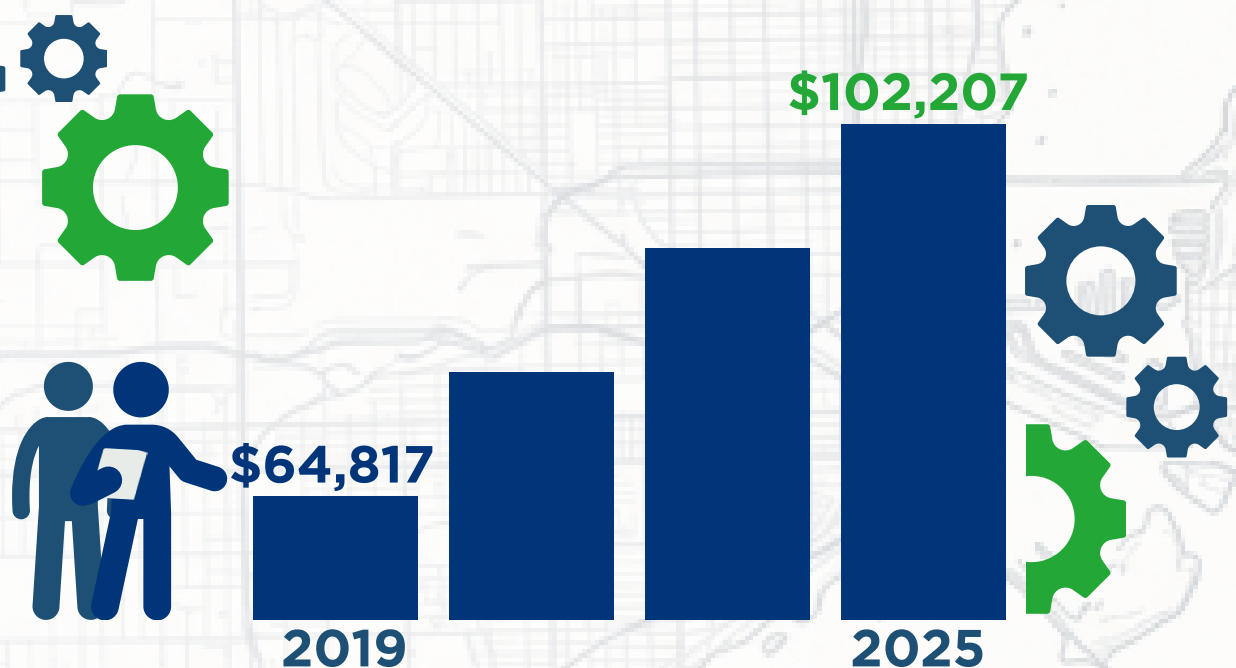
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GROSS REGIONAL PRODUCT

What is Gross Regional Product (GRP)?

Total value of all goods and services produced specifically with Miami-Dade. GRP is a primary metric to measure a region's **Economic Health**. Attracts major business investments, leading to **Higher Wages** and **Improved Living Conditions**.

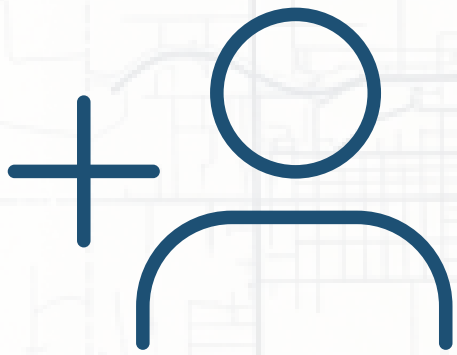
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
