





Economic Recovery

- 4.1% decrease in unemployment rate from June 2020 to June 2021 in Miami-Dade County.
- O 19.3% decrease in first-time unemployment claimants from June 2020 to June 2021, for 3,331 first-time total unemployment claims.
- O In June 2021, Miami-Dade County lost 5,700 jobs, compared to the 32,600 jobs gained in June 2020.
