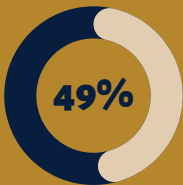


Annual Hurricane Mitigation and Preparedness Poll

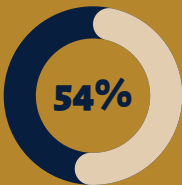
Action, Confidence, and Awareness

Feel somewhat or extremely vulnerable to damage from a hurricane, related tornado or flooding hazards



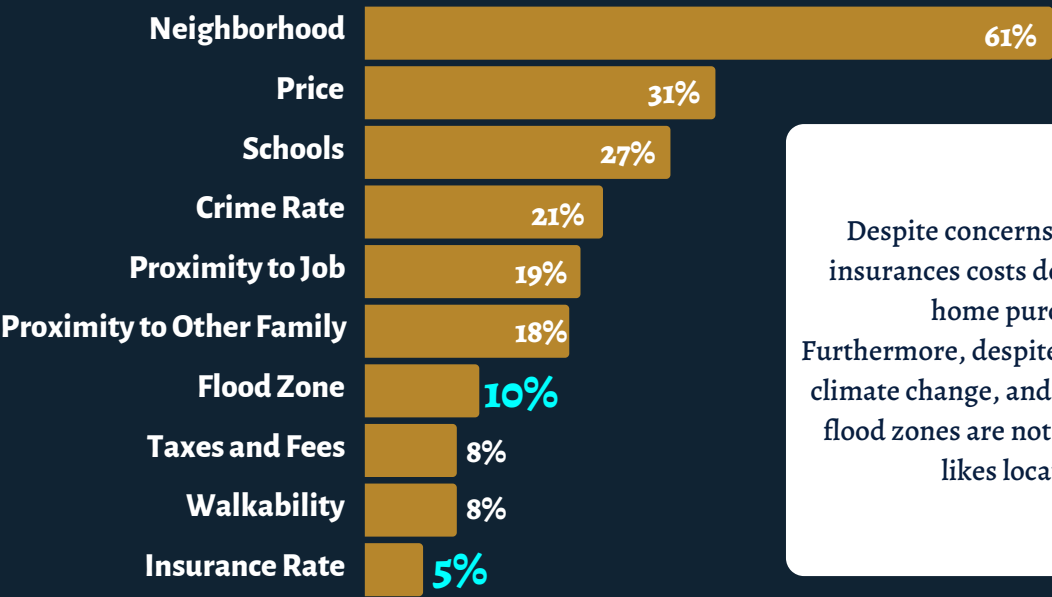
Are willing to accept tax increases, up from 46% in 2021.

Why are homebuyers choosing their homes?

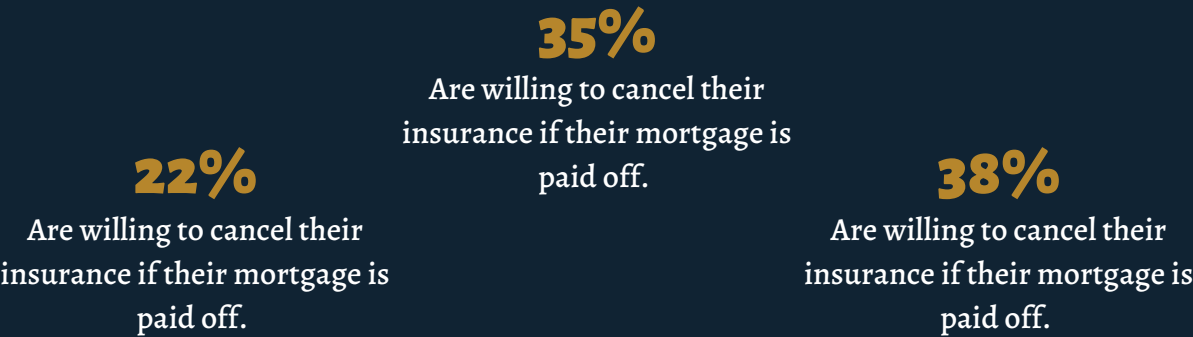
When you purchased your home, which characteristics were the most important?

Insurance Coverage and Housing Affordability

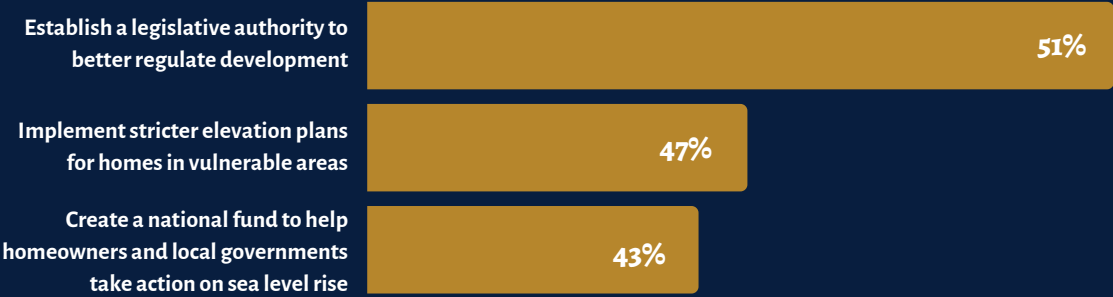
Increasing insurance rates, coupled with the affordable housing crisis, are causing a rise in homeowners who are willing to accept high deductibles or forgo insurance coverage.
