




### **REGISTERED VOTERS VS. VOTER TURNOUT**

## USA VS. FLORIDA

#### AS FLORIDA GOES, SO GOES THE NATION

Even though Florida did not decide the 2016 Presidential Election, the Florida vote still predicted the outcome.

A higher percentage of white men and white women in Florida voted for Trump compared to the rest of the nation.

While nationally 29% of Latinos voted for Trump, 35% of Florida Latinos favored the Republican candidate.

Latino women in Florida voted for Trump at a higher percentage (34%) compared to the U.S. (26%). More significant, still, Cuban-Americans in Florida favored Trump even more (54%).
