

# Florida Household Pulse

May 21st - May 26th  
(Week 4)

The Household Pulse survey is designed to inform federal, state, and local responses to the needs of its community. It measures household experiences during the COVID-19 pandemic on a weekly basis.

A large number of residents still continue to experience the COVID-19 impact in terms of loss of income, ability to pay rent, food insecurity and healthcare access. However, we are starting to see a decrease in the share of the population who are adversely affected.



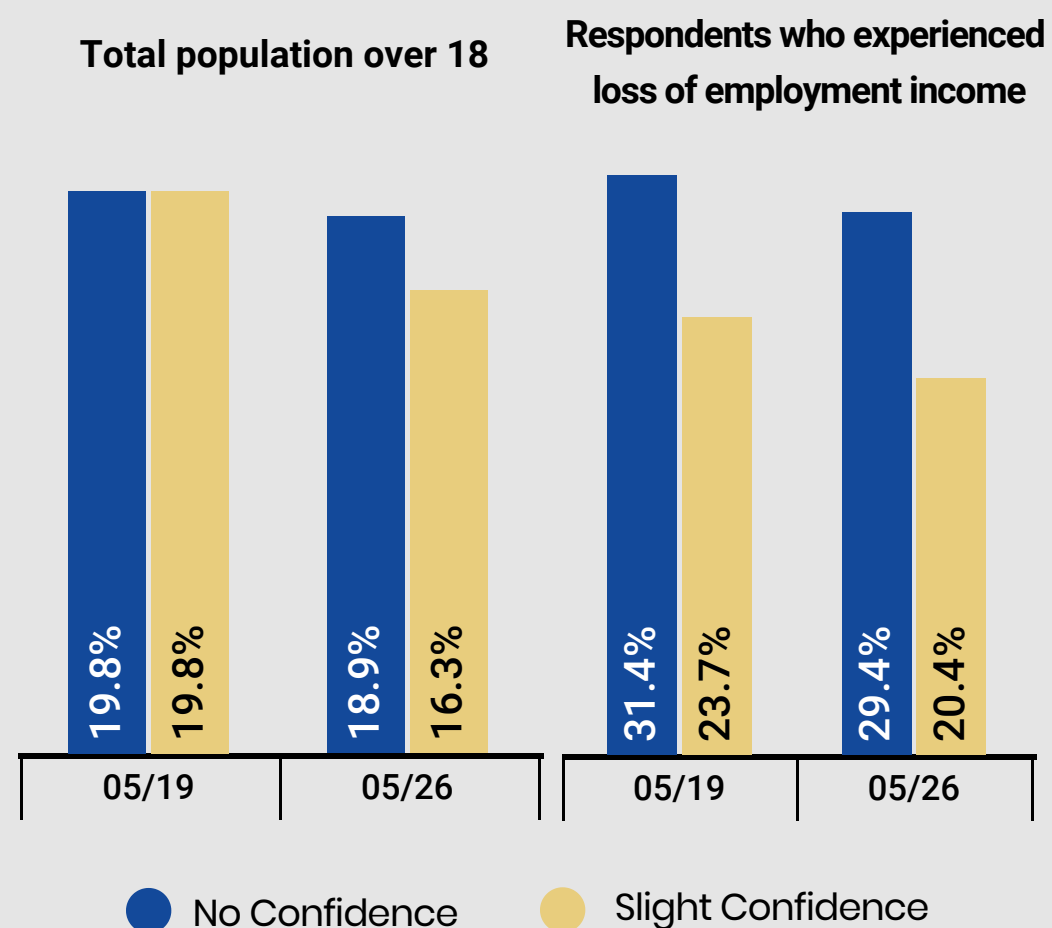

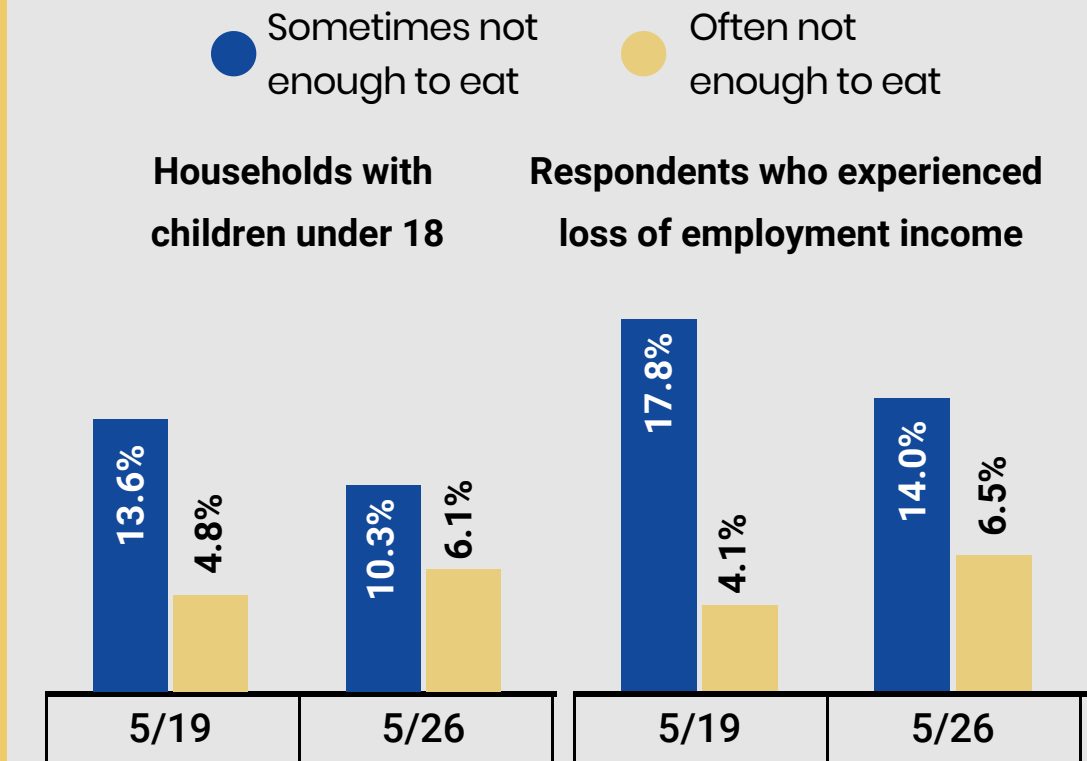
# 56.0%

of households with related children under 18 **experienced loss of employment income** (for self or household member) since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, a 3.1% decrease from week 3.
