




HOSPITALIZATIONS FOR MOOD AND DEPRESSIVE DISORDERS




SUICIDE DEATHS



In 2021, elders had the highest rate of suicide deaths per 100,000 people in Miami-Dade. Overall, the suicide rate per 100,000 increased from 8.5 to 9.0 in Miami-Dade County.

SUICIDE DEATHS BY AGE GROUP IN MIAMI-DADE, 2021 (RATE PER 100,000)






ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES
