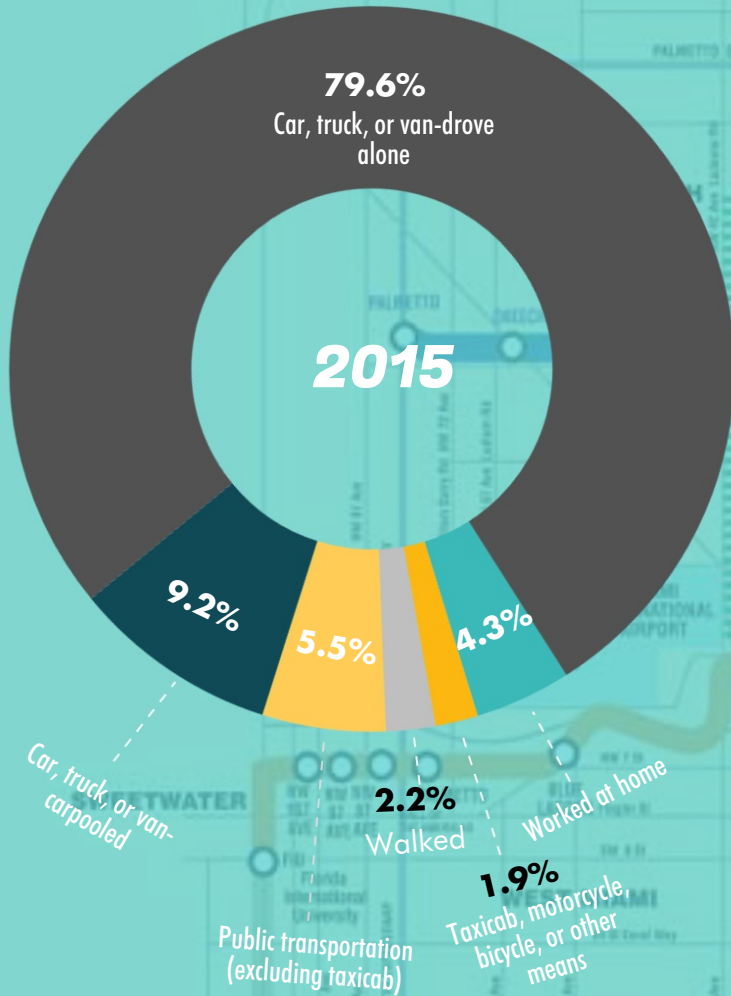


TRANSPORTATION IN MIAMI



Public transportation use among young residents increased from 2010 to 2015.

Telecommuting or working at home increased significantly among all age groups.

Miami-Dade residents of all age groups continue to rely primarily on cars to commute to work.

Overall use of public transportation remained the same, but it has increased among young residents and decreased among the older.

Public transit ridership decreased by 7% for the January through July period of 2016 compared to the same period in 2015.



More than 50% Vancouver workers use means of transportation other than their car to commute to work.
