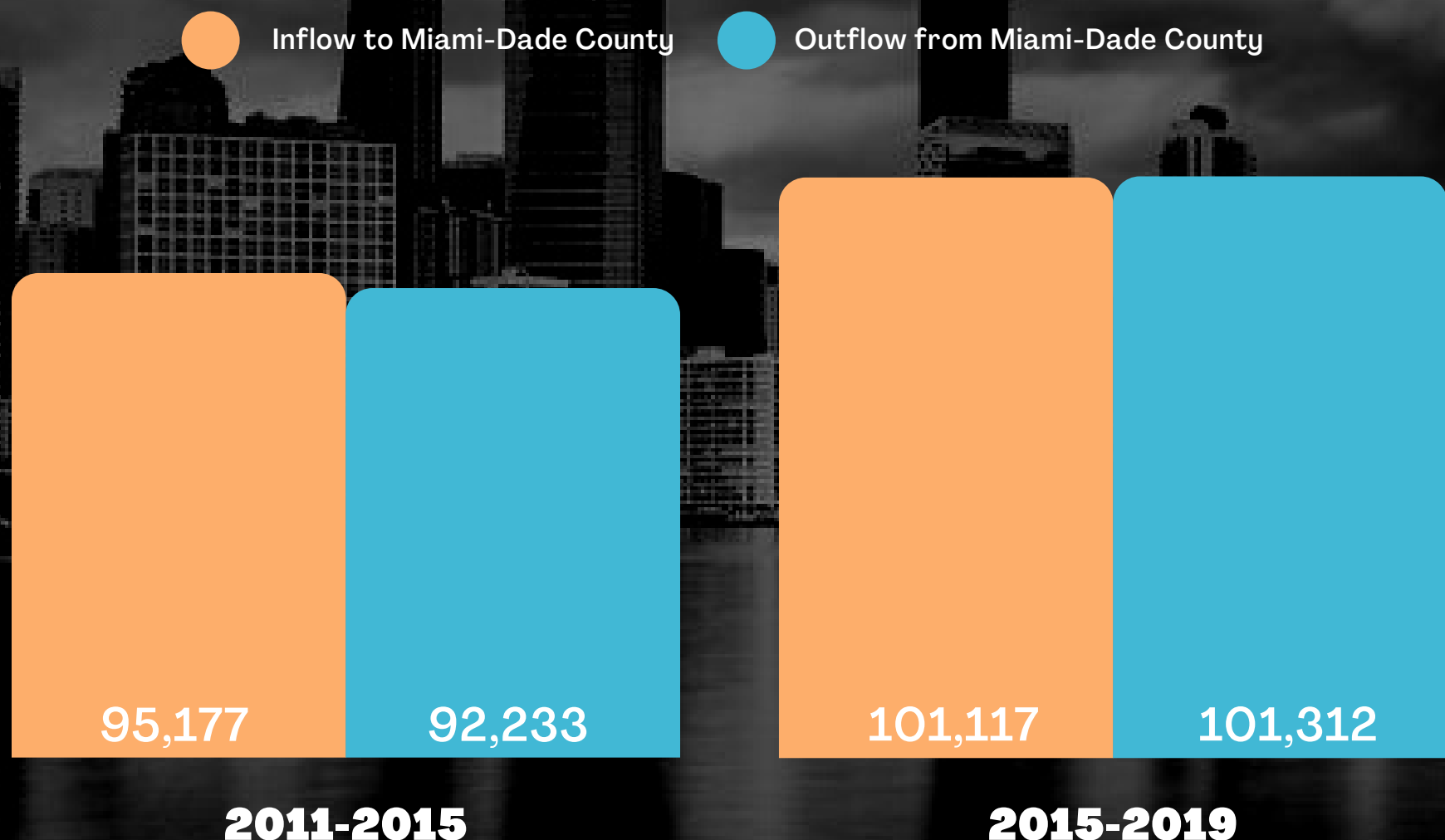

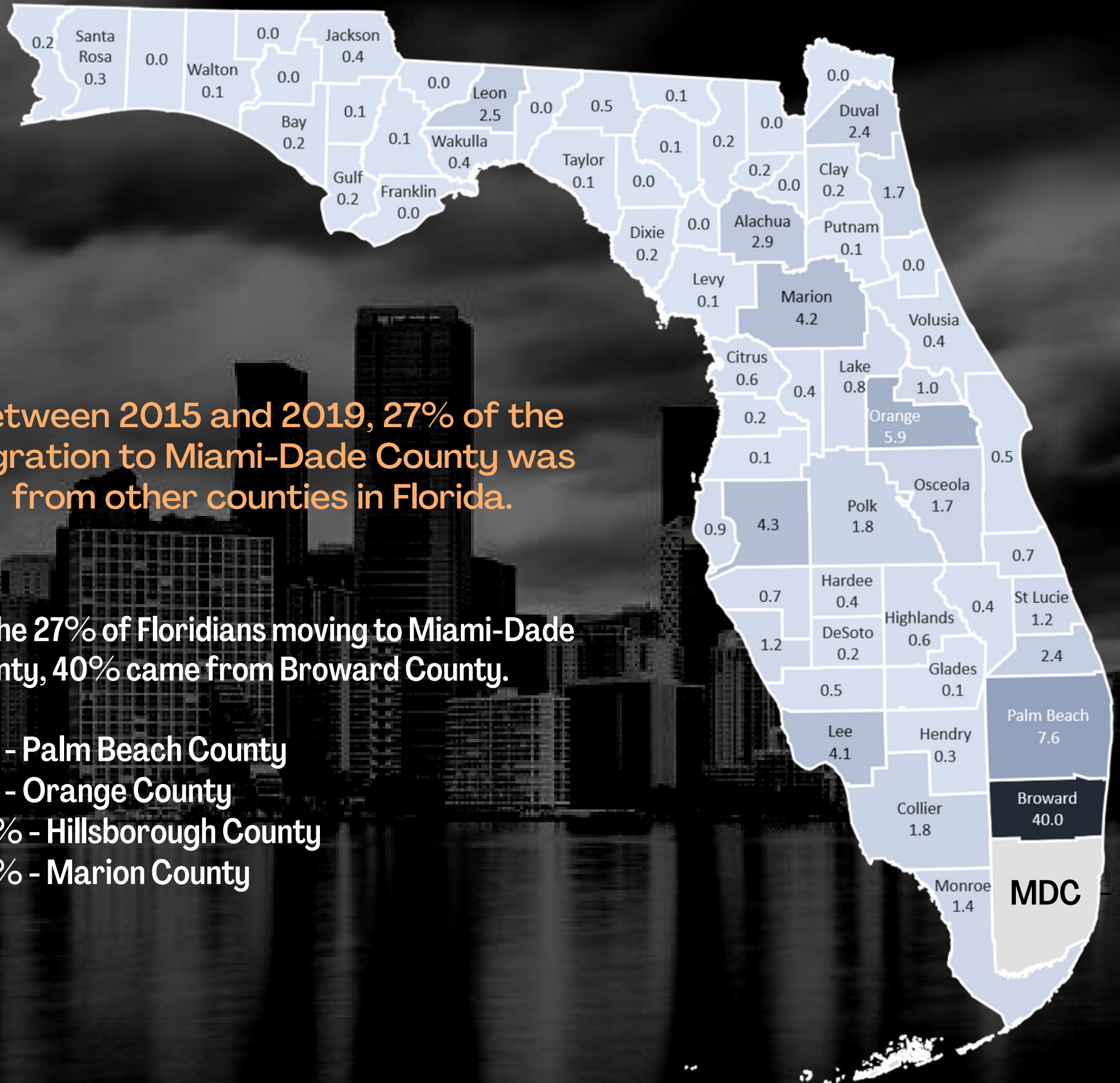
Population changes in Miami-Dade County

Population growth has increased statewide by 1% from July 2020 to July 2021, adding 211,305 more residents. This growth was mostly concentrated in the North and West regions. In the same time, Miami Dade County population declined by at least 1.6%, the second year in a row with population decline. The population decline has not been offset by in-migration.

Moving to Miami-Dade County: Florida



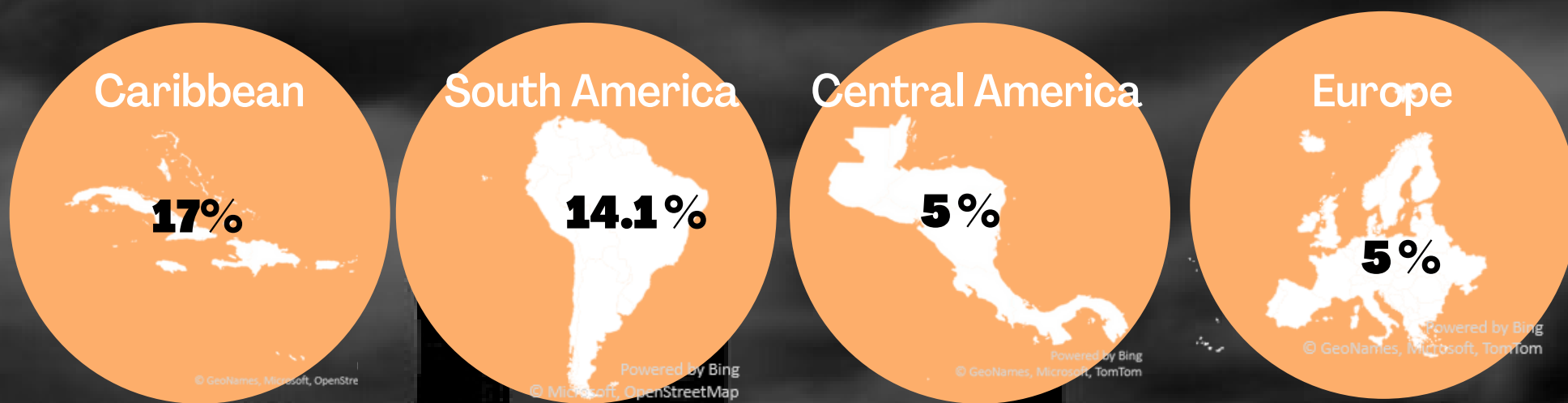
Between 2015 and 2019, 27% of the migration to Miami-Dade County was from other counties in Florida.

Of the 27% of Floridians moving to Miami-Dade County, 40% came from Broward County.

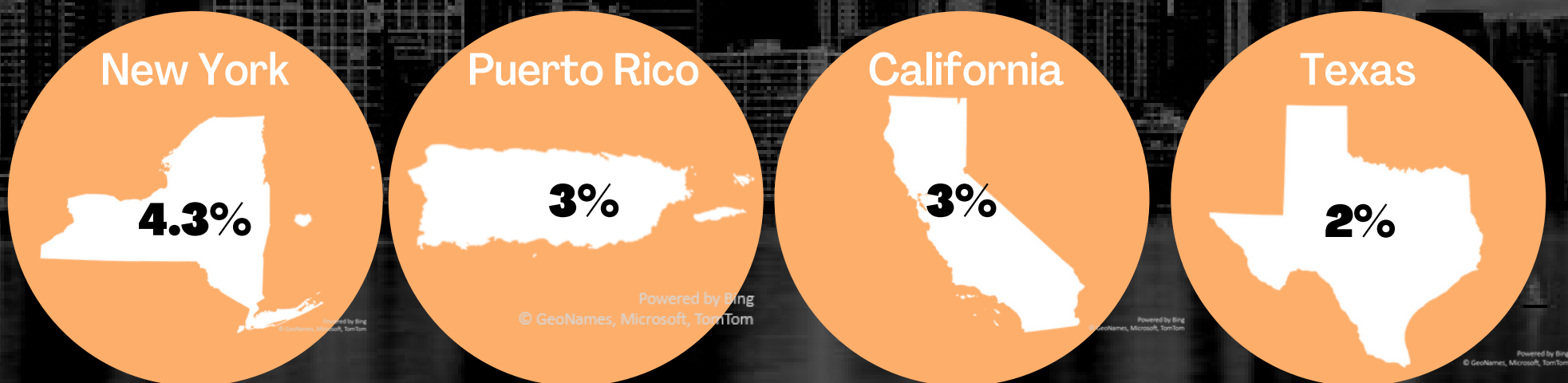

Moving to Miami-Dade County: International and Domestic Flow

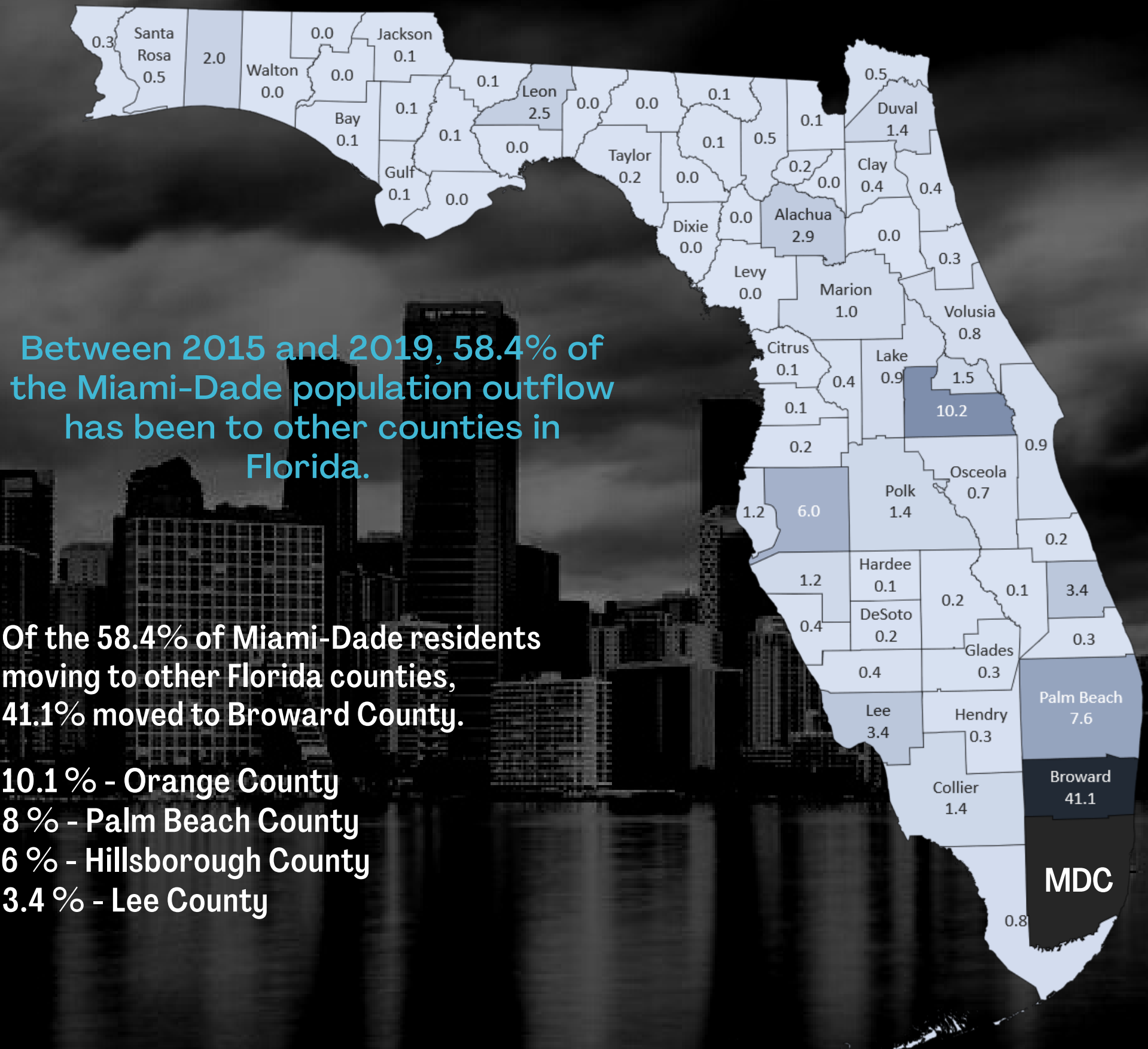
45% of migration to Miami-Dade County was international. The top four regions for international migration were:
