

Black/African American veterans decreased 1% since 2019



Since 2015, there was a 9% increase in veterans who identify as Hispanic/Latino



11% decrease in White, Non-Hispanic veterans since 2015




In 2020 there was an 8% increase of veterans of Other races/ethnicities (Including AAPI, Alaskan and Native Americans, and people who indentify with more than one race)

Veteran Educational Attainment

Less than high school graduate



Bachelor's degree or higher 35.3%



GED or Equivalent 23.9%

Some college or associate's degree 33.4%



Declining veteran population in the county reflects an overall 16% decrease in educational attainment since 2015



69% of the veterans in the county have some college, associate, or Bachelor's degrees or higher education



The proportion of veterans with less than high school education increased 1.4% since 2015



Since 2015 there was a 4.35% increase in veterans with Bachelor's degrees or higher and a 3.64% decrease in veterans with some college/associate's degrees

Veteran Median Income, 2015-2020








Since 2015, veteran median income increased 11.7% for men and 4.3% for women.



The income gap between men and women grew by 5.66% since 2015. In 2020 alone, male veterans earned around 21% more than female veterans.

Veteran Poverty in MDC






Between 2015 and 2020, the number of veterans below the poverty level has decreased 0.18 %, with a corresponding 0.18% increase in veterans above the poverty level



However, between 2015 to 2019 veteran poverty had decreased by 0.34%. The rebound that saw a 0.16% increase in veteran poverty in 2020 was probably a result of the economic impact of the Covid-19 Pandemic
