METRO-MIAMI ACTION PLAN (MMAP) TRUST'S COMMUNITY MEETING AND RETREAT THE COMMUNITY'S CALL TO ACTION

Metro-Miami Action Plan (MMAP) Trust will host a **COMMUNITY MEETING AND RETREAT** – **THE COMMUNITY'S CALL TO ACTION** on Saturday, July 28th, 2007 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. There will be a press conference held at 11:00 a.m. at Miami-Dade College's (MDC) Chapman Conference Center to report findings from a public opinion survey of Blacks in Miami-Dade County, conducted in March by the Metropolitan Center at Florida International University.

The Metropolitan Center was commissioned by MMAP to conduct a Thirty-Year Retrospective analysis of the Black community in relation to changes in its demographic, socio-economic characteristics, and education. The study findings serve to exemplify the disparity the currently exists between Blacks and other residents of Miami-Dade County in these and other sectors.

Discussions and workgroups will be held on the following topics: Housing, Economic Development, Criminal Justice, Education, Public Health, and Advocacy Initiatives and Programs. They will be lead by local Government and Community leaders. There will also be discussions the effects of recent budget cuts on the quality of life for our community, especially the Black residents of Miami-Dade County.

The results of the Thirty-Year Retrospective will be revealed at the press conference. Both the community meeting and press conference are free of charge and open to the public.

This is the perfect opportunity for the residents of Miami-Dade County to voice their opinions about what is going on in their neighborhoods. The Community Meeting and Retreat takes place on Saturday July 28th, 2007 at Miami Dade College – Wolfson Campus, The Chapman Center – Building #3, 300 N.E. 2nd Avenue, Miami, Florida 33132.
